From Lanaihale you can see nearly all of the other Hawaii islands as well as historic Maunalei Gulch. Other notable sights are Kaunolu Village, the abandoned fishing villages of Lopa, Naha and Keomuku, Shipwreck Beach, and the south-easterly shore facing Hulopo'e Bay with its crystal-clear waters perfect for snorkeling.
